

**KXCI COMMUNITY ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERS MEETING
KXCI PUBLIC FORUM MEETING
JUNE 8, 2004 5:30 PM KXCI Studios**

Attendees: Sonya Figueroa (CAB Secretary), Jim Lipson, KXCI BOD, Roger Greer, KXCI Program Director, Larry Bruce, KXCI General Manager.

Concerned Listener #1

- 1) Is this a designated CAB meeting? If so, why is only 1 member (Sonya Figueroa) at the designated meeting place/time? What is/are the normal meeting dates? Who attends?
- 2) Re. Programming
 - a) More local affairs & local/global community programmers such as David Yerkey's "A View from Slightly Off Center."
WHY WAS THE BEST LOCAL PROGRAMMER SUSPENDED??
 - b) Democracy NOW! 2x/day for those who can only listen early or late.
 - c) Reinstate any/all programmers who were similarly fired, if they wish to continue doing their work for the real people of the community who want REAL RADIO.
 - d) Focus on a progressive, NON-COMMERCIAL, grassroots attitude, vision, mission, Pacifica is a pretty good model.
- 3) Why am I only allowed to ask about/raise issues of programming here? What is up with this obsessive/compulsive paranoia & control, & fear of risk-taking, & lack of listening to the needs/preferences being expressed by some community members/listeners/supporters who really care?

Concerned Listener #5
